

ENHF SID RWY 22 (RNAV, CAT H) - ROUTES

REMARKS:	CAT H only.
RADIO COMMUNICATION FAILURE:	Squawk A7600. Maintain last assigned LVL for 2 minutes, then climb to CPL cruising LVL. Aircraft under vectoring shall, after set transponder to A 7600, proceed in the most direct manner possible to rejoin the CPL route no later than the next significant point, climbing to the CPL cruising LVL taking into consideration the applicable MNM flight ALT.
CLOSE IN OBSTACLES	Rising terrain, up to 0.15 NM from THR 04, requires more than 3.6 % climb gradient and must be avoided visually or by other means
VECTORIZING/ DIRECT ROUTING:	When being vectored or cleared for DCT routing, the climb gradient(s) stated in SID “RESTRICTIONS”-table apply.
ATC CLEARANCE:	Departing IFR flights shall obtain ATC clearance from HAMMERFEST INFORMATION.
NON RNAV 1 ACFT:	At first contact with HAMMERFEST INFORMATION state “UNABLE RNAV 1 DUE (reason)”. OMNI-DIRECTIONAL DEPARTURE available (see ENHF AD 2.24)
NOTE	Gradient is less than the recommended minimum value (5.0 %) in ICAO DOC 8168 VOL II.
